Black Jack Skier Development Program: Fee Policy

The Black Jack Skier Development Program (BJSDP) Committee sets program fees annually, as part of the annual budgeting process. Fees for the various skier development programs are based on the level of effort required to support the program and on the cost to supply the services covered by the program. This includes the level of coaching effort and the resources required for the respective levels of competition and athlete maturity. Program fees go towards the following: coaching expenses for routine and out of town events; van and trailer maintenance and covered transportation costs; physiological testing; support for coaching salaries; equipment and accessories required for athlete support, including Zoom subscription, test skis, radios, tent, etc.

BJSDP's non-profit programming is highly reliant on volunteer support. Each athlete registration has an associated volunteer time requirement. The number of hours required is based on the program level. Volunteer hours are to be tracked on the *BJSDP Volunteer Hours Log*, found on the BJSDP Policies + Forms webpage: www.skiblackjack.ca/sdp-policies-forms. The *BJSDP Volunteer Hours Log* is to be submitted to the volunteer coordinator at the end of the season.

The annual fees are subsidized by volunteer work, along with general grants, skier performance-based grants, and fundraising. Program fees are based on the expected number of athletes and the estimated grant income for the year.
