RACE FEES: \$5 per race for U6, \$15 per race for U8 to U12, \$25 per race for U14 to U23, seniors,

masters and recreational. GST and Zone4 fees will be in addition to these race fees.

LICENSES: No race license is required. Racers must be current members of a

Nordiq Canada or US Ski Association registered club.

WAIVER FORMS: Waivers will be accepted online via the Zone 4 registration.

START LISTS: Start times for each race will be posted at the race office and online by 11:00 PM on both Friday, Jan 13th (Classic Technique Individual Starts) and on Saturday, Jan 14th (Skate Technique Mass Start).

BIB PICKUP: Saturday: 9:30 AM -10:30 AM in the Race Office.

Sunday: 8:00 AM - 9:00 AM, in the Race Office.

The Race Office will be located in the grooming shed, adjacent to the trailhead cabin

There will be no bib-pick-up allowed 30 min prior to the start of all races.

AWARDS: The U6 athletes will receive their ribbons directly after their event. U8 and U10 age

categories will have an awards ceremony part way through the day as soon as results become available. All other age groups will have awards presented approximately 30

minutes after the last racer finishes.

Ribbons and medals provided by Teck will be given to participants aged 15 and younger, as follows: 1st, 2nd and 3rd place medals for age categories for 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15 year olds – both male and female will be awarded. Ribbons for 4th and 5th placed skiers will be provided for the above age categories, as will participant ribbons for all children 7 years of age and younger. Older age groups will be given

local medals.

FACILITIES: There is a heated trailhead cabin available. In addition, there are outhouses located

nearby. First aid attendants will be present on site. There are no dogs allowed on our

trails.

FOOD & DRINKS: Post-race drinks and a cookie will be offered to racers in the finishing chute. Coffee

and snacks will be available in the trailhead cabin to all racers and volunteers on Saturday. A contribution to the Black Jack Skier Development program donation jar

would be greatly appreciated.

WAXING: An area is available to set up waxing tents to the east of the finish line, near the

sea cans. Waxing in the parking lot is also allowed for wax trailers.

All coaches, wax technicians, and parents are requested to abide by the

self-governed <u>CCBC Waxing Protocol</u> while waxing skis for all athletes (this includes all age groups and recreational skiers). Note that fluorinated glide wax, including

Low-Fluoro (LF) is prohibited.
